COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

- Blend (read)/segment (write) simple words and short sentences e.g. The frog had a flag
- Letter recognition and correct formation
- Retell stories and recall events in order including familiar fairy tales.
- Reinforcing rhyming and alliteration
- Recognise tricky words e.g. I, the, are
- Show and Tell

MATHEMATICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Find the total number of items in two groups by counting all of them
- Begin to use vocabulary involved in adding and subtracting (more and less)
- To begin to use simple language related to weight/capacity/size
- To understand directional language.
- Sorting objects into sets
- Recognise and order numbers to 20 and beyond
- Missing numbers
- Number formation

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- To continue to follow the behavioural expectations in the setting
- To have increased responsibility over their own and others' belongings
- To consider the consequences of their words and actions for themselves and others
- Health awareness in summer e.g. sun cream and sun hats
- To prepare for a new year group.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Gym
- Move with control and co-ordination
- Show awareness of space of themselves and of others
- Using tools confidently and with control
- Manipulate materials – play dough
- Use a range of small and large equipment

- Explore a range of materials.
- Craft activities related to our topics
- Develop accuracy with drawing activities.
